
City of Allen, EDC and CDC March 2019 - Revenue Report

Sales Tax:

Below is the monthly summary of sales tax receipts for the March 2019 reporting period, which reflects sales that took place in the month of January 2019. March 2019 receipts were \$3,054,591, which represents an increase of 5.1% from March 2018 receipts of \$2,906,383. Collections year-to-date equal \$14,212,529 or 12.42% more than the same period last year. At 8.91%, Dallas had the highest increase for the current month as compared to the prior year, while Plano had the weakest showing at -5.83%. Receipts for Collin County were down -0.07% over this time last year and the State of Texas' collections were 5.91% higher. Audit collections for the period were -\$37,522.


